

34th Annual Scholarship Application

There are a total of \$10,000 in Scholarship funds for graduating high school seniors pursuing their education at a college, university, or trade school, returning college students, or graduate students.

Eligibilty and Requirements

To be eligible applicant must:

- Be a Kaua'i resident
- **Be a Kaua'i FCU member or be willing to become a member (**become a member online or visit a Kaua'i FCU branch)
- Be a graduating senior class of 2023 from any public/private high school or home school and be in good academic standing or a returning college or graduate student
- Show proof of acceptance into any accredited college or university as a full-time student.

How to apply:

- Fill out the application in its entirety
- Collect supporting documents listed below
- Drop off to the Lihue or Kilauea branch in a sealed envelope labeled 'Scholarship'
- or mail to:

> The deadline to submit is March 31, 2023 Mail must be postmarked March 31, 2023

Application will be disqualified if all documents are not attached at time of judging.
Two letters of Recommendation : Letters from teachers, employers, clergy or any non-related individuals who can attest to the applicant's character and potential.
Current Official Transcripts: Student must have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average throughout their final three years of high school or previous year in college and submit a current official transcript.
Proof of Acceptance: to any accredited College or University
Financial Need: A FAFSA OR parent's 2021 Federal Tax Return or Personal 2021 Federal Tax Return.
Essay or Personal Statement: Submit an essay or personal statement of at least 200 words on why you are applying for the Kaua'i Federal Credit Union Scholarship.
Academic Achievements and Community Service: leadership, honors, extra-curricular activities, volunteer, school clubs or any other supporting documentation.
