

# **35th Annual Scholarship Application**

There are two \$5,000 scholarship funds available for either graduating high school seniors or returning students who are continuing their education at a college, university, or trade school. This opportunity is also open to returning college students, graduate students, or those pursuing a PhD.

### **Eligibilty and Requirements**

#### To be eligible applicant must:

- Be a Kauai resident
- **Be a Kauai FCU member or be willing to become a member (**become a member online or visit a Kauai FCU branch)
- Be a graduating senior class of 2024 from any public/private/home school and be in good academic standing or a returning student.
- Be enrolled for the 2024 school year in any accredited school, college or university as a full-time student.

#### How to apply:

- Fill out the application in its entirety.
- Collect supporting documents listed below.

- Drop off to the Kapaa, Lihue or Kilauea branch in a sealed envelope labeled 'Scholarship'

The deadline to submit is April 8, 2024 Mail must be postmarked April 8, 2024

Application will be disqualified if all documents are not attached at time of judging.
<b>Two letters of Recommendation</b> : Letters from teachers, employers, clergy or any non-related individuals who can attest to the applicant's character and potential.
<b>Current Official Transcripts:</b> Student must have maintained at least a 3.0 grade point average throughout their final three years of high school or previous year in college and submit a current official transcript.
Proof of Acceptance: to any accredited School, College or University.
<b>Financial Need:</b> A FAFSA OR 2022 Federal Tax Return (if minor a parents Tax Return will suffice).
Essay or Personal Statement: Submit an essay or personal statement of at least 200 words on why you are applying for the Kauai Federal Credit Union Scholarship.
Academic Achievements and Community Service: leadership, honors, extra-curricular activities, volunteer, school clubs or any other supporting documentation.
