

Annual Scholarship Program

The Kauai FCU Foundation is proud to offer \$10,000 in academic scholarships to support the educational goals of Kauai students. Scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors and returning students enrolled full-time at an accredited college, university, graduate school, PhD program, or trade school for the upcoming school year. The Foundation Board determines the number and dollar amount of scholarships awarded annually.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Be a Kauai resident.
- Be (1) a graduating high school senior from any public, private, or homeschool OR (2) a returning student currently pursuing trade school, a college degree or higher.
- Provide proof of full-time enrollment at an accredited college, university, graduate/doctorate program, or trade school.

Judging Criteria:

Applications will be scored based on the following weights:

30% Academic Achievements / GPA

30% Extracurricular Activities

15% Personal Essay

15% Special Topic Essay

10% Financial Need

Required Documents:

*Incomplete applications with missing documents will not be considered

- **1. Two Letters of Recommendation:** From teachers, employers, clergy, or non-related individuals who can attest to your character and potential.
- 2. Official Transcripts: Must be marked 'official' with the school's official stamp.
- **3. Proof of Acceptance or Enrollment:** Provide proof of full-time enrollment at an accredited college, university, graduate or doctorate program, or trade school.
- **4. Extracurricular, Volunteer, & Leadership Activities:** Fill out the table of your most significant extracurricular, volunteer, and leadership activities.
- **5. Personal Essay (200–500 words):** Write a personal essay of 200 500 words on who you are, your educational goals, and why you are applying for a Kauai FCU Scholarship.
- **6. Special Topic Essay (200–500 words):** Answer the question: What does strengthening the social fabric of our Kauai community mean to you?
- **7. Financial Need Form:** Complete the financial need form. Please include your household income if you cannot be claimed as a dependent. *Note: Awardees will be required to provide support to verify reported figures.
